# OUR RESEARCH IMPACT

**Making a positive impact on our local areas, as well as the wider world, is a big part of what we do, and in today's world, doing what we can to benefit our planet is more important than ever.**

**Our research forms a big part of that. Whilst our academics are leading researchers, we also aim to give our students the opportunities to participate and get involved wherever possible.**

We care about sustainability, wellbeing, health, social justice. We care. This is just some of our research impact.

We care about our local area; every farmer in the Lake District is set to receive 'What Did Farming Ever Do For Us?' by Professor Lois Mansfield, the first publication of its kind, setting out why famed cultural landscapes matter in the crusade for nature recovery and climate action.

We are supporting the education of new sonographers through a virtual North West Ultrasound academy, to tackle ultrasound workforce shortage.

We have a centre for research in health & society, a centre for national parks & protected areas, Learning education & development, a centre for regional economical development, an initiative for leadership and sustainability, a child, youth, family, and community network, a teacher education advancement network, a health and society knowledge exchange facility, an active ageing research group, an arts research initiative, and a social issues in medical imaging research group.

We care about positively impacting our world, and improving the lived experience of people everywhere; from talks and project features at COP26, to reintroducing wildlife into the UK, to foetal facial recognition (listed as among the most important discoveries of 2017) to exploring psychological impacts on domestic abuse.

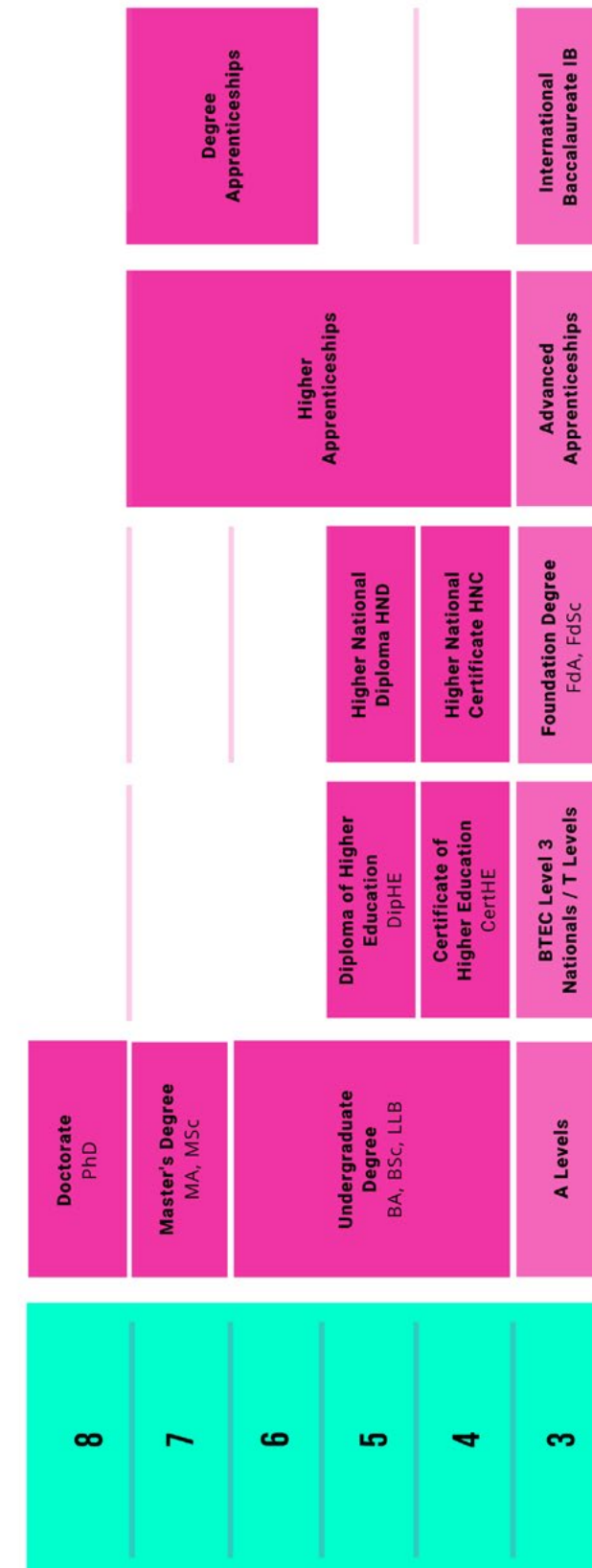

# QUALIFICATIONS

The awards we currently offer are:

- **BA/BSc Honours degree:** a full-time degree over three years. Some programmes have an optional sandwich or placement year.
- **LLB:** Law degree.
- **BA/BSc with integrated foundation year Honours degree:** a full time degree over four years. Degrees with foundation years are designed for students who may not have the necessary entry grades for an Honours degree programme or who are returning to study later in life. Some Integrated Foundation Year programmes will allow you to apply for another degree programme.
- **FdA or FdSc:** a stand-alone foundation degree course, full-time for two years. Usually linked to a specific professional career. This qualification can be topped up to a full BA or BSc Honours degree via a top-up course.
- **DipHE/Cert HE:** a two-year Diploma/one-year Certificate of Higher Education qualification.
- **BA/BSc Top-up:** allowing you to top up your qualification to a full degree with this one-year full-time course; these courses help students who have already completed a foundation degree, an HND or a DipHE course to gain their full Honours degree qualification.
- **Degree Apprenticeship and HLA (Higher Level Apprenticeship):** will help you get a qualification through a levy paid by your employer. This means that you 'll learn and get qualified on the job while earning an income.

# ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

We consider all aspects of your application, not simply your qualifications and grades. We are interested in your personal statement, reference and any relevant experiences as well as your academic background and performance.

As part of the selection process the university will consider additional contextual information and use this additional information as part of the decision-making process.

# FEES & FUNDING

When you study at the University of Cumbria you are investing in your future. We work hard to ensure that your degree is worth every penny by helping you graduate from university career-ready.

Here's how it works:

- You don't have to pay tuition fees up front. You study now and pay later. This means that repayments are based on what you earn, not what you owe.
- As of April 2021, you only start repaying once you are earning over £27,295 a year p.a. Even then, the terms are modest and it comes straight out of your wage automatically so there are no messy payment arrangements to make.
- To cover your living costs including accommodation while you study with us, you can apply for maintenance support.
- Currently, a student who usually lives in England can receive a maintenance (living cost) loan of up to £9,706 (London rate is £12,667) depending on what their household income is, and whether they live away from home. Students from other parts of the UK are able to access similar support.

## FINANCE AND FUNDING

Details of funding are published by Student Finance England and the equivalent agencies in Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland. You

should check their website for updates and apply online as soon as possible, as well as checking the University of Cumbria website nearer your start date for the latest information.

Maintenance loans are repaid in the same way as your tuition fees; the repayment terms and conditions may vary depending on funding body.

To support our environmental target, we are pleased to be working with a local business,





Cumbria Waste Group, for our main site waste management services. CWG were appointed to help improve the amount of waste being recycled by separating at source. The university now segregates into three streams – Paper & Card, Co-mingled (plastic, tins & glass) and non – recyclable.

CWG is responsible for emptying over 100 bins each week across our four main campus sites in Carlisle, Lancaster and Ambleside.

The University of Cumbria is a licensed waste carrier. Our licence number is **CBDL135305**.

This allows us to carry waste directly to waste recycling or disposal sites, or between our main campus and ancillary sites.
