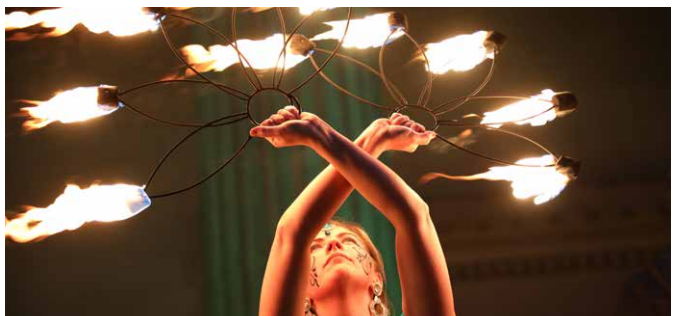

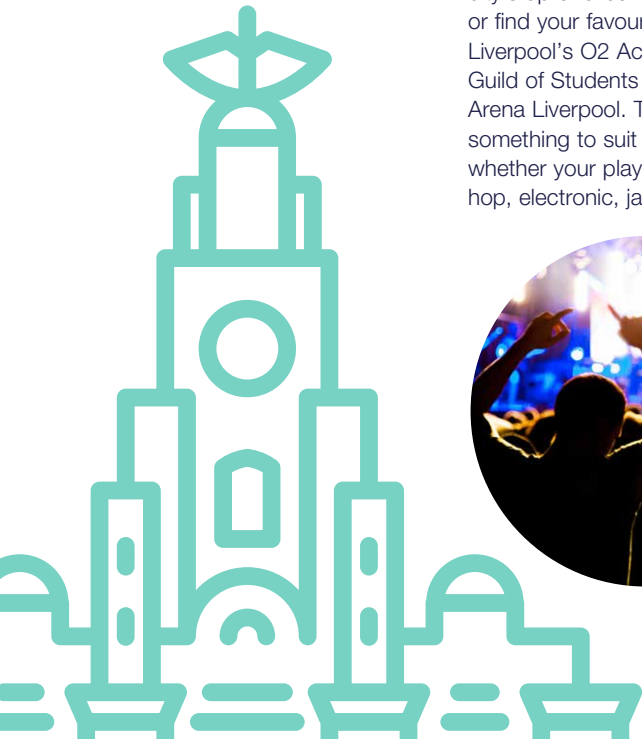
FOOD AND DRINK

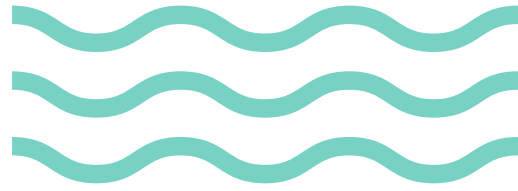
SHOPPING

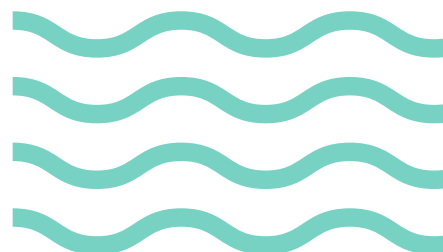
OUR LOCATION

There are major motorway links to the M62, M57, M58 and M56 and all are within easy reach of the city centre and LJMU itself. Liverpool is well served by public transport too, with a mainline railway station (Liverpool Lime Street) located right in the city centre, a National Express coach station, a ferry terminal and an underground railway. In addition, there are two city centre bus stations, taxis are cheap and plentiful, and, if you need to go over the river, you can always take a ferry across the Mersey.

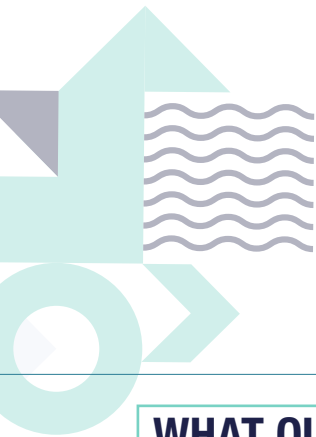

WHAT OUR STUDENTS THINK

Alejandra Cardona Mayorga from Colombia decided to take the next step in her studies for her Masters in Film at Liverpool John Moores University.

Hear what she has to say about her experiences studying at LJMU and in Liverpool...

WHY DID YOU CHOOSE LJMU?

I chose LJMU because the university offered the postgraduate programme that I was particularly looking for and was excited to study. After reviewing many universities in the UK, finding this programme was great and so I knew LJMU was for me from there.

Especially as the course included the module in Exploring Film Festivals, Distribution and Exhibition, which has since fulfilled my expectations about the film industry and confirmed what I should expect from a career in this field.

DO YOU FEEL SUPPORTED BY THE UNIVERSITY AS AN INTERNATIONAL STUDENT?

I have always received academic and emotional support at LJMU. All my lecturers have been very kind and have helped to guide me through to make the most of my postgraduate course. They, combined with the well-being, careers, and academic skills achievement teams, have made me feel very supported and capable in setting my own personal and academic goals.

WHAT IS ONE OF YOUR FAVOURITE THINGS ABOUT LJMU?

I love the wide variety of study spaces available, which are suitable for what you want and need to do. My personal favourite place is the Student Life Building, as it has so much natural light, and very open spaces to work and study. The fact that it is also open 24/7, has helped to make me feel like there is always someone available to help you, which is a nice feeling as an international student!

WHAT DO YOU LOVE MOST ABOUT LIVERPOOL?

Liverpool is a very easy-going city! And everything is very close to the university. If you live in the city centre, you will be able to find lots to do, including visiting the museums, walking through the Docks, enjoying some student budget-friendly meals along Bold Street, and of course, exploring some historic places where the Beatles made their first steps in the music world. Here in Liverpool, you are going to feel inspired!

WHAT TIPS WOULD YOU GIVE TO ANYONE LOOKING TO STUDY IN THE UK?

Do not panic if the English that you learnt in your home country sounds very different when you first arrive here. There are slang words, various English expressions, and also the intonation of the words can be difficult to comprehend for the first couple of months. However, with time and patience, you will begin to understand and then be able to express yourself in a very confident way, in English.

WHAT OUR STUDENTS THINK

Samina Tahir from Pakistan decided to take the next step in her studies for her Master's in Digital Marketing (with Advanced Practice) at Liverpool John Moores University.

Hear what she has to say about her experiences studying at LJMU and in Liverpool...

WHY DID YOU CHOOSE LJMU?

The main reason I chose LJMU was the course outline and subjects taught, which covered both theory based learning and practical implementation. I believed this would help one to understand in a comprehensive manner, the skills which are now much needed in the digital marketing field.

WHAT WOULD YOU LIKE TO DO FOLLOWING YOUR STUDIES?

For the last 15 years or so, when working in the professional environment, digital marketing is something you cannot avoid. Especially, if you intend to sell financial products and services. This was my foundation of where I wanted to develop more understanding of this field. As such, I decided to take a break from my work and come to learn about digital marketing, which will help me move forward in my career. Digital marketing in this era helps one to grow better in their respective career, and once I am finished with my studies, I expect the same. Especially, in Pakistan (my home country) where there is a big focus on digital marketing.

DO YOU FEEL SUPPORTED BY THE UNIVERSITY AS AN INTERNATIONAL STUDENT?

It wouldn't have been possible to focus on my studies and career at the same time, without the support I get from my teachers, fellow students, and the people behind Career Zone. Initially the anxiety of restarting the student life and moving country looked like a hard task, but the wellbeing advisors and my teachers made it all feel easy. I am really thankful to these teachers for making me feel comfortable during this whole process.

As an international student, I did not have much understanding on how to make my CV presentable and what a cover letter is etc. The staff at Career Zone really helped me with these tasks.

The Skills department have also been a great help when learning about new things like SPSS, referencing and more.

Last but not least, UNITEMPS have been a great support in terms of helping me to get part time work. They have helped me to get a real feel of working in the professional environment alongside my studies.

WHAT TIPS WOULD YOU GIVE TO ANYONE LOOKING TO STUDY IN THE UK?

You should have a specific goal when you are planning to study in the UK. If you know what your goal is, you can keep an eye on all the available resources that will help you to reach this goal including studying in the UK. The UK is a land of opportunities and if you are proactive and ask for help, you will be able to study successfully to then get a relevant job.

HOW TO APPLY

APPLY

We recommend submitting your application as early as you can to allow time for application and visa processing. Furthermore, some of our programmes are increasingly popular and applications will close for these throughout the academic year.

Undergraduate students can apply via the UCAS application system at www.ucas.com. This is a secure online system, and is suitable if you have regular access to the internet.

Postgraduate students can apply directly to the University for most courses. Use our online search tool to select the course you are interested in and then choose the option to 'Apply Direct'.

Both undergraduate and postgraduate students can apply through one of our international education partners. They are familiar with our application process and have a lot of experience of helping students to apply to Liverpool John Moores University. RECEIVE AND ACCEPT YOUR OFFER

If you applied via UCAS

You can log on to UCAS Track to see the progress of your application. Once we have made a decision on your application we will update UCAS and you will be able to view and accept your offer online.

If you applied via our education advisers or partners

Your adviser will contact you to update you about the status of your offer and can contact us directly to accept the offer on your behalf. If you have any questions about the status of your offer, please contact your chosen education adviser directly.

If you applied directly

You can log in to your account on our website to track your offer status. Once we have made a decision on your application, we will send you an offer letter to the email address you have provided. To accept your offer and secure your place with LJMU, you will need to click the 'green' accept button in this offer letter.

COMPLETE DEPOSIT PAYMENT

The deposit for international students on undergraduate and postgraduate courses is £4,000. This will be confirmed in your offer letter, and the deposit amount will be deducted from your tuition fees with the remaining amount payable by enrolment. You should pay your deposit after meeting your offer conditions, following which you will receive your CAS (Certificate of Acceptance for Studies).

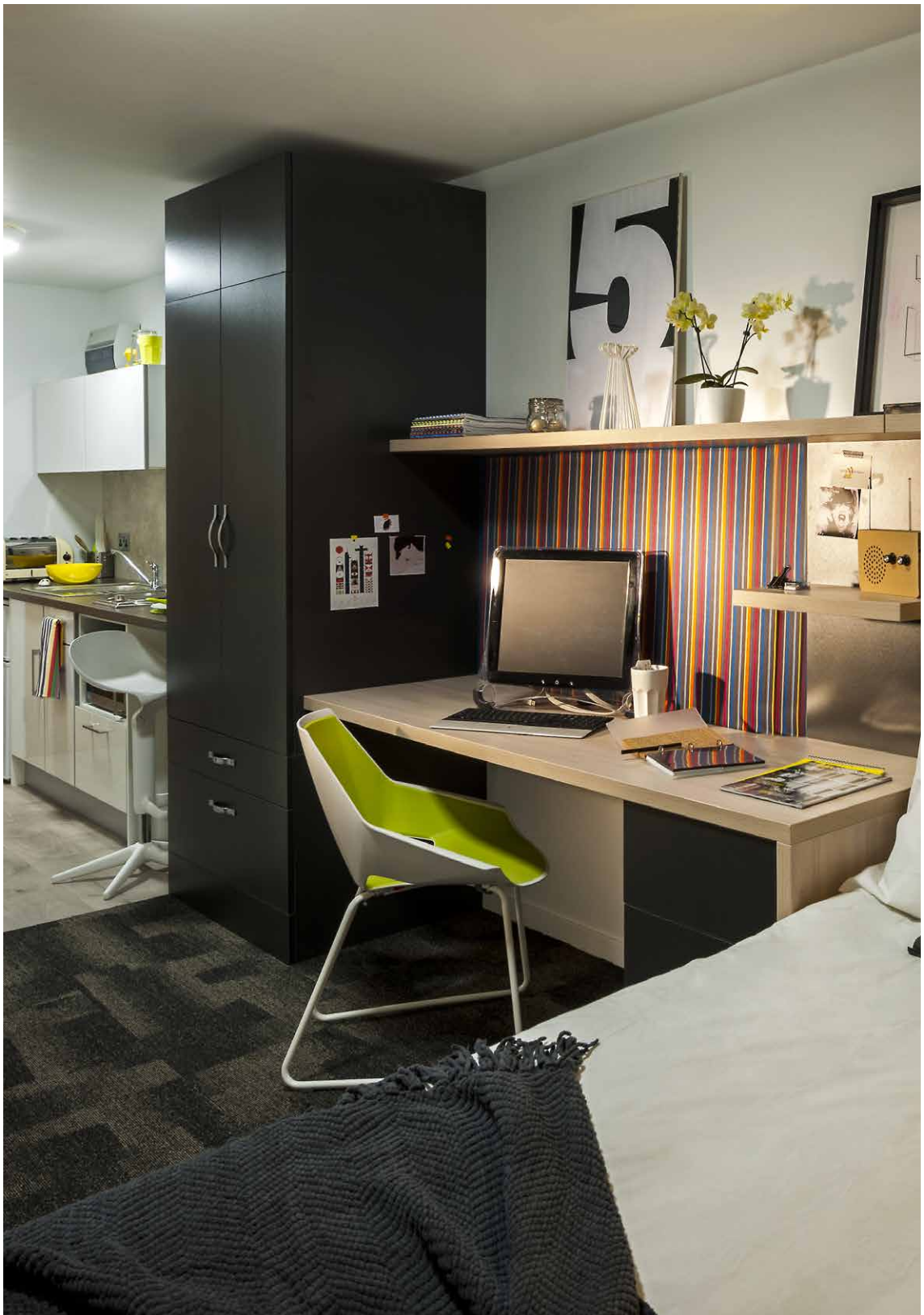

DEPOSIT

Unless exempt, (see exemptions online) international students will need to pay a minimum deposit of £4,000 to secure their place at the University. This deposit will enable the release of the Confirmation of Acceptance of Studies (CAS), which you will need to apply for your student visa.

HOW TO PAY

You will be able to pay your deposit via LJMU's on-line payment system www.flywire.com/pay/ljmu. You will need your LJMU Applicant ID number and course start date (month and year) in order to complete this transaction.

Before you arrive, you will need to pay an additional amount to equal 50% of your overall fee for the year. If you are in receipt of an LJMU Scholarship, this will be deducted from your second, remaining installment for the year (usually due four months from your start date).

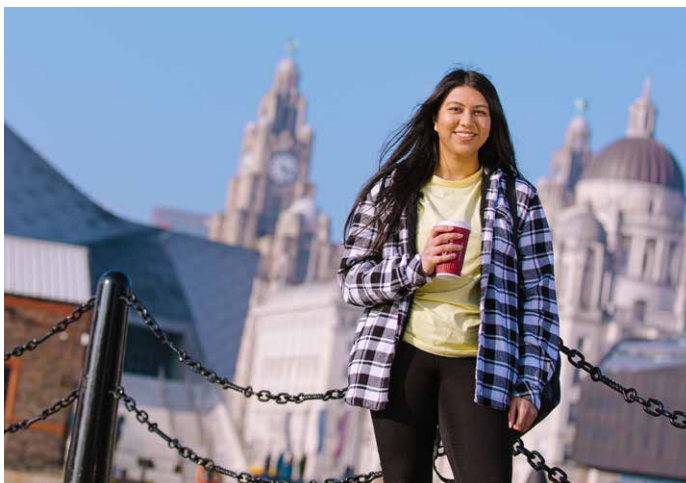

- The minimum scores required by the University are listed below in accordance with UKVI regulations, although specific course requirements may differ:
- International Foundation Year: 4.5 IELTS* or equivalent (min 4.0 in writing)
- Undergraduate: 6.0 IELTS or equivalent (min 5.5 in each skill)
- Postgraduate: 6.0 - 7.0 IELTS or equivalent (min 5.5 in each skill)

The English language entry requirements stated are for information regarding entry to the course. If you require a UK visa to study, depending on the type of visa you need, the English language requirements and valid English tests to satisfy the UK visa criteria may differ.
